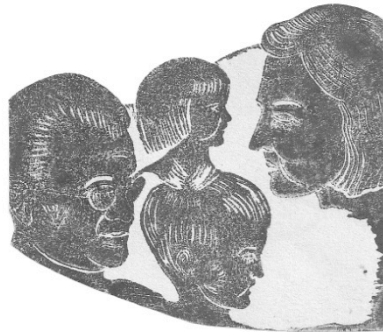


Please join us for a reception here at the church, following the memorial.
